

## CLOCK BIBLE STUDY INSTRUCTIONS

Christians are told that they are to redeem (buy back) time! "Redeeming the time, because the days are evil" (Ephesians 5:16). How can we use a clock as a personal Bible study tool?

Step 1 Write the verse reference for your devotions at the space at the top of the clock.

Step 2 Divide the words in the verse into 12 parts and write the words in each clock number section.

Step 3 Read the verse carefully, thinking about the meaning to you, and then write it in motto form at the place below the clock face.

Step 4 Draw the clock hands on the two or three most important sections of the verse on the clock face.

Step 5 Set the alarm hand at any warning section in the verse. This can be something that the Holy Spirit wants you to particularly watch out for today.

Step 6 Save your work and review it at the end of the week, month and year. You will notice that God has been quietly working in your life to create His timing in you!

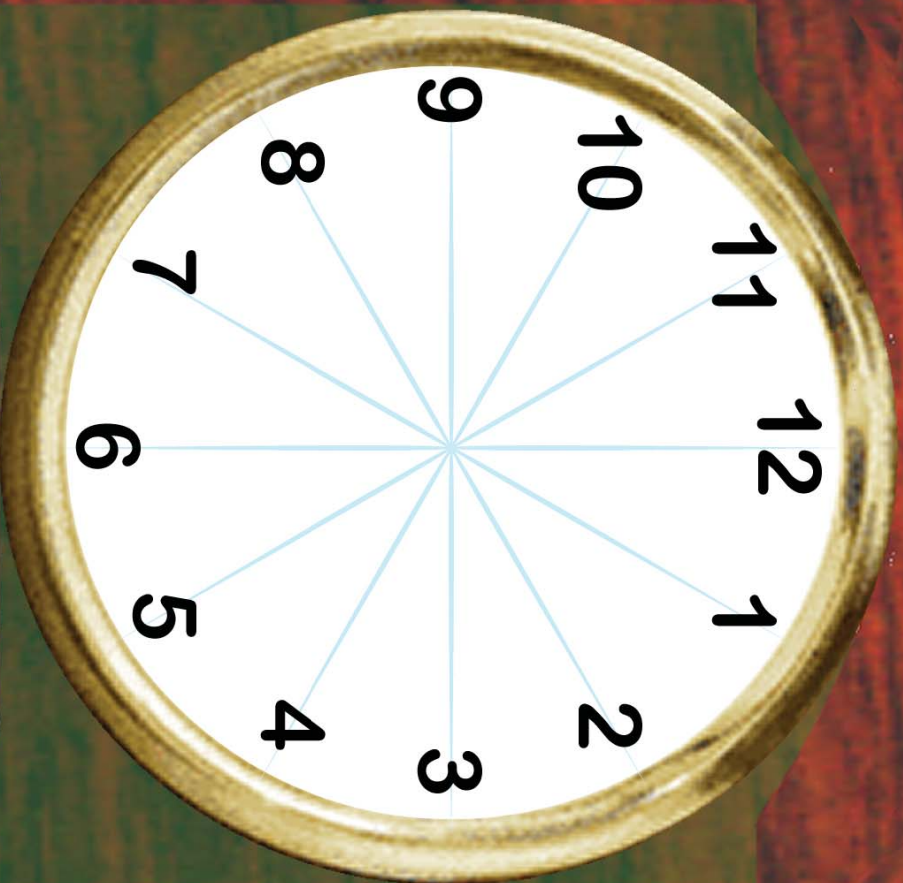
